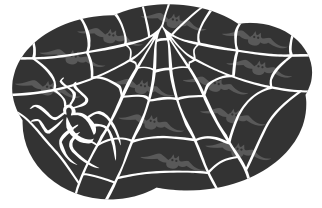

**City Of Fort Wayne Dog and Cat Restraint Laws and Provisions State**

**Off Property** - All dogs and cats must be under the physical control of the owner or attendant by leash when off the owner's property. Their excrement must be removed immediately when on public lands. Now open is Pawster Park Dog Park, located in Foster Park, and available for off-leash exercise of dogs.
