The Winter Season is Here Again!

The first snow fall will be just around the corner. Here are a few tips to help the association provide the best street clearing possible by our contractor and the city. Following these tips will help keep your association dues down.

Your Help Is Requested. Living Art Landscaping was awarded the plowing contract this year and has some requests of the residents of Aspen Village. They will do their best to have us plowed out by 5:30 am. If there is a large amount of snowfall or will continue to fall, they will come through and open up a main pathway on each street and return later the same day to open up the street completely. **We need your help in keeping cars off the streets** to allow plows to come through swiftly and complete the job. Any car left on the street will be plowed around and an additional charge will be billed to the community for a return trip to remove such snow. Each entrance to the neighborhood will have a green sand/salt barrel. Please use these barrels as needed as they are filled by the City. Report any issues to John Harrington or any other board member as soon as they occur (see page 2).



City Snow Removal

The Street Department is in charge of keeping the City of Fort Wayne's streets free of ice and snow during inclement weather. Whenever there is a danger of icy or snowy conditions on the roadways of the city, the Street Department will monitor conditions and respond accordingly. When snow or ice begins accumulating on the streets, plowing and/or salting operations will commence.

Due to a poor response time by the City in clearing residential streets, we have elected to hire an independent contractor to clear our streets as mentioned above.
