Message From the President



Recently, there have been reports of residents' mail being stolen from their mailboxes. Stolen mail can often result in identity theft and other serious financial issues. Please report any suspicious activity involving mail fraud to local law enforcement. **REMEMBER:** Always pick up your mail every evening and do not put any mail out for the mail carrier until the morning of the next pick-up.

In the event you do have an issue like this, it is recommended that you freeze your credit to prevent identity theft and further fraud. You need to do this with all 3 credit bureaus. The following are a few helpful internet links to sites where you can do this online.

It is also recommended that you request a fraud alert. You will need to do this with one of the credit bureaus and they will report to the other two. This should only be done if you suspect you could be the victim of identity theft.
