<p>With this newsletter your annual Aspen Village Dues Notices are enclosed. Our dues have helped fund many important upgrades in Aspen Village. These funds will help upgrade street signs, the small swing set by the tennis court, repair the swale off of Rainer Pass, ball diamond back stop needs attention, repair tennis court surface, and continue to improve the overall aesthetics of the neighborhood. In addition, they pay for the ongoing maintenance of the neighborhood, mowing of the common areas, snow removal and also utilities.</p> <p><b><i>Dues must be paid no later than July 1, 2013.
